- Research mission needs, fair trade sources
- Plant a garden - donate produce to shelters
- Visit/provide transportation to shut-ins, sick, elderly, etc.

- Be an advocate for issues such as hunger, human rights, etc.

Ongoing Collections

- Fabrics (cotton is preferred), bed sheets, pillow cases (for quilts)
- Yarn-regular worsted and baby (for knit hats, mittens, baby sweaters, and other items)

- Pull tabs from beverage cans
- Cards & envelopes (new) given to Lasata Care - can be the promotions cards you get in the mail
- Items you don't need - call Mission Action Team to locate a new home for your donation
